The Central Methodist ChurchBelperGENERAL INFORMATION

The Wesleyan Chapel as it was originally known, situated in Chapel Street was erected in 1807 to seat 1400 persons.

Methodism in Belper probably had its foundations as a result of John Wesley preaching there on several occasions. The increase in membership was so rapid that by 1826 the Belper Circuit had no less than 1048 members, 30 local preachers and 13 chapels.

Today, the same building stands in a prominent position within its neatly tended burial ground, which is now closed. The memorials, as will be seen by the plan, are mainly placed round the edges.

EXPLANATION OF ABBREVIATIONS AND SYMBOLS

The memorials have been copied verbatim, including epitaphs if any, and have been typed as such except where the symbol / indicates a new line in the original inscription. Where the symbol - - - is used, those words or letters are eroded and therefore not decipherable or visible. Letters underlined mean that we think the word or letter is correct but that the memorial was difficult to read.

Immediately after each inscription is an indication of the form the memorial takes, e.g., (S. H.) would mean that the memorial is a Slate Headstone. The following is a full list of the abbreviations used.

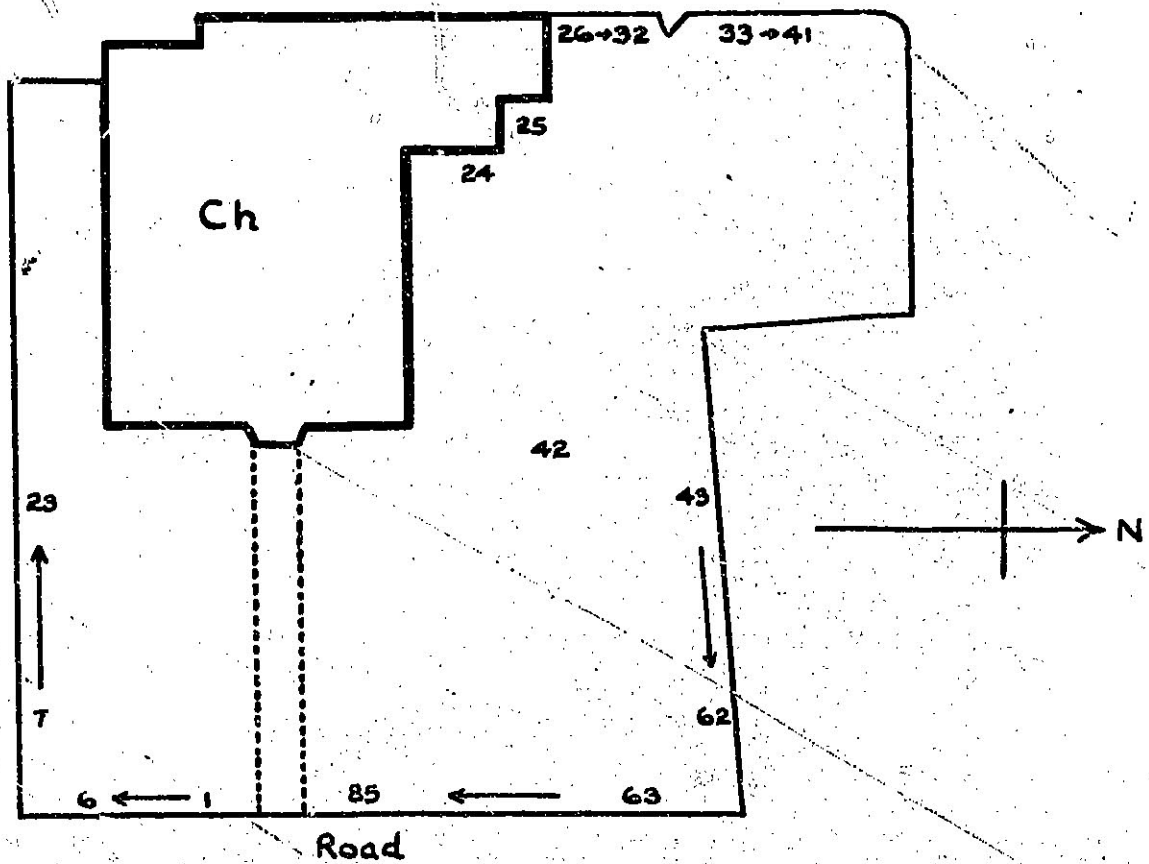
INDICES
