# ST. JOHN THE EVANGELIST HAZELWOOD, DERBYSHIRE

### GENERAL INFORMATION

Once part of the large parish of St. Alkmund, Duffield, the parish of Hazelwood, to include Shottle and the surrounding hamlets, was created in 1846 when the church of St. John the Evangelist was dedicated. In 1863 the church of St. Lawrence, Shottle was built to serve that outlying area, although only licensed for baptisms and marriages.

In Feb 1902 the church at Hazelwood suffered a major disaster when much of the inside and roof was gutted by fire. Restoration took place immediately and the cost was raised entirely by public

subscription.

Registers of baptisms, 1847 - 1885, and burials, 1847 - 1904, for Hazelwood are now deposited at the County Record Office, Matlock, as are the baptism registers for Shottle, 1863 - 1922. Registers of marriages, and later baptisms and burials are held by the present incumbent who is vicar of both parishes.

### EXPLANATION OF ABBREVIATIONS AND SYMBOLS

The memorials have been copied verbatim, including epitaphs if any, and have been typed as such, except where the symbol / indicates a new line in the original inscription. Where the symbol — — is used, those words or letters are eroded and therefore not decipherable. Letters underlined mean that we think the word or letter is correct but that the memorial was difficult to read.

Immediately after each inscription is an indication of the form the memorial takes, e.g. (S. H.) would mean that the memorial is a Slate Headstone. The following is a full list of abbreviations used.


